Enabling organizations to use the Internet as a vehicle for communications and service delivery, AWD Thin Client[™] offers powerful browser-based integration with the Automated Work Distributor[™] (AWD[®]).

AWD Thin Client offers a browser-based alternative to the traditional AWD desktop. Anyone with a valid ID can access AWD Thin Client through an intranet or Internet connection and perform regular AWD tasks such as:

- Lookup
- View Source
- Process Work
- Create Work
- Create Source

AWD Thin Client is ideal for associates who need remote access to AWD or use a small portion of AWD's functionality. For example, a branch manager can use it to check account status or update account information. Because it requires minimal system resources, AWD Thin Client can be accessed from any workstation that supports a Web-enabled browser.

Three-Tiered Architecture

Using the latest in object management architecture, all AWD Thin Client processing is performed on a middle tier, AWD/NetServer[™]. This centralization eliminates problems resulting from incorrect workstation configurations and facilitates client support. AWD/NetServer receives data from the AWD host server and converts it to HTML.

AWD data transferred through the Internet is secured with existing AWD security views and AWD/NetServer's logon routine.

Utilizing this three-tiered architecture, AWD Thin Client reduces the total cost of ownership by:

- Minimizing hardware and software requirements for client workstations.
- Minimizing support requirements.
- Minimizing LAN/WAN bandwidth requirements.

Customize AWD Presentation

Using HTML templates, organizations can customize AWD Thin Client's "look and feel." These templates enable organizations to add their company names and logos to each page or modify the overall page design.

If an organization requires customized functionality, it can extend or modify components of the thin client server application. The server's Java infrastructure makes its implementation and integration virtually limitless.
